He isn't the first to do so, but the list of writers to succeed at this is a short one. Can we just talk about Lee's art in this one? He's never let me down and today was no exception. Sometimes he does a panel or a spread that makes me ridiculously envious of his talent. And yes, his inker and colorist both play huge roles in the final product, but goodness does he give them some beautiful places to start. Oddly enough, the few appearances of Batman were the highlights for me and were also the source of the only two laugh out loud moments. And, boy were they doozies. I'd have to imagine that a true Superman fan would have rated this a 5 star without question or reservation.
