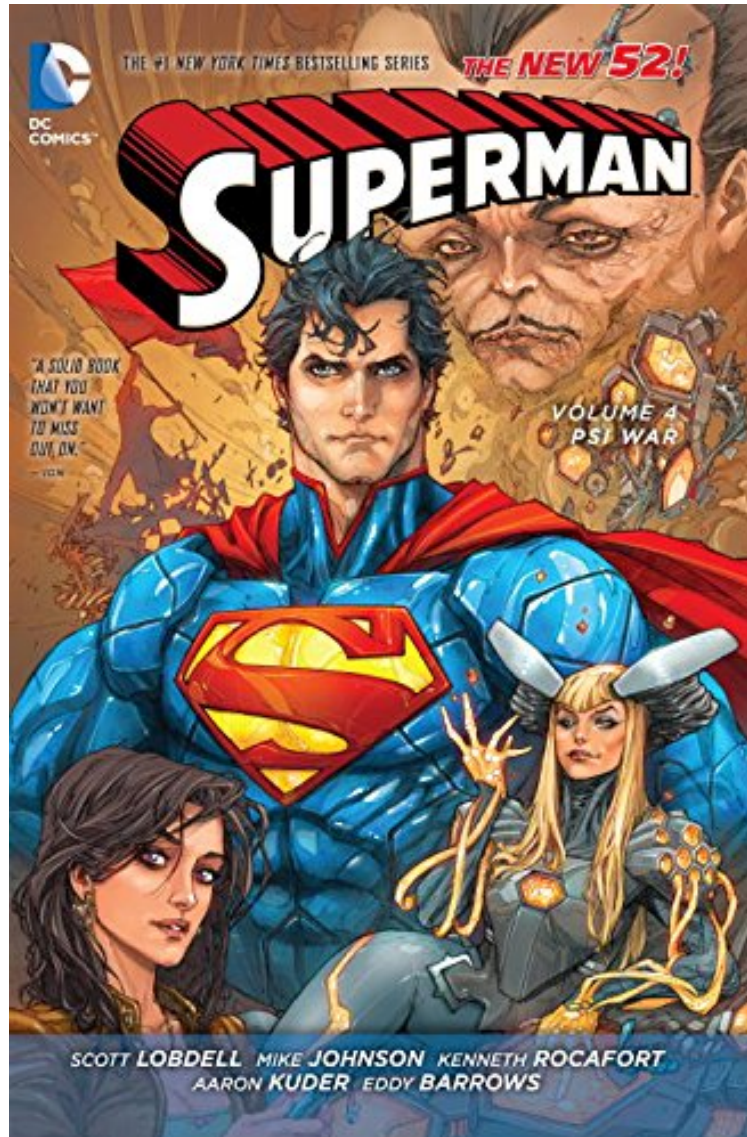

Scott Lobdell had a great idea with his He'l on Earth story, but it still lacked many things. This book however, is really great. I was skeptical at first because the villains advertised on the front aren't villains that i'm really accustomed to and I felt like

the story would be boring because of that. However, Hector Hammond and the HIVE Queen are great villains. Their psychic powers actually make it challenging for the Man of Steel to counter, and that's something that is rarely seen. Constantly, Superman would fall defeated to their attacks on his mind and making Superman seem more weak or at a disadvantage made this book really good. Superman would now need to develop a strategy instead of just constantly attacking his foes.
