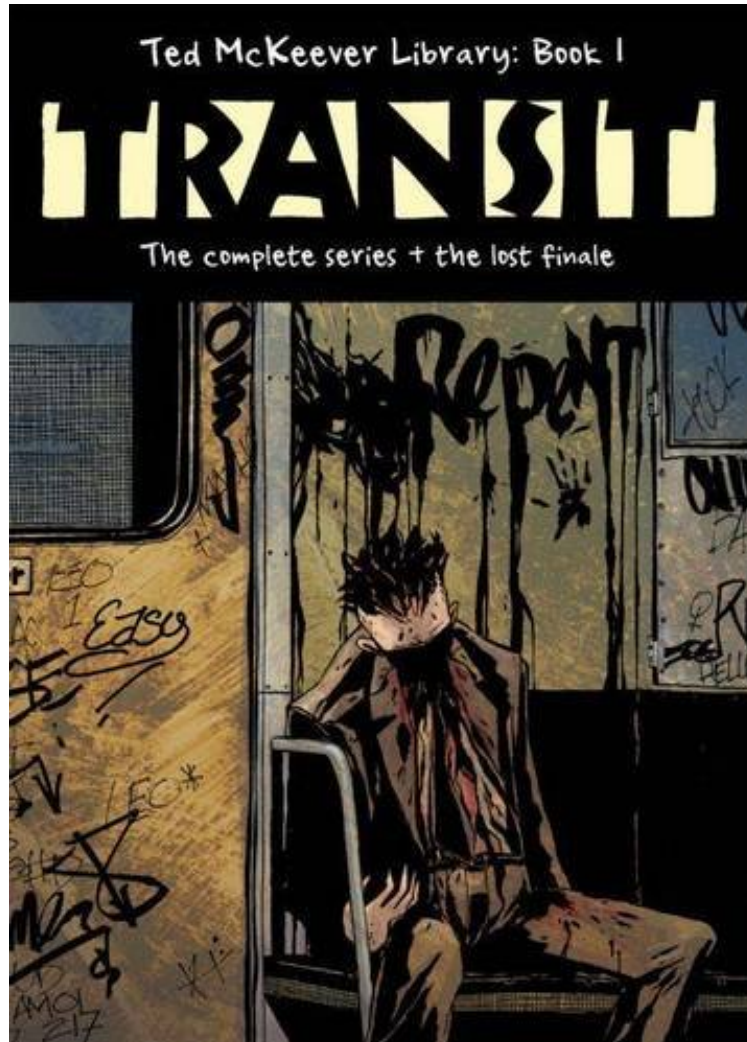

Published in a compact hardcover format, slightly smaller than the original comic originally released in 1987, it collects the entire original series and a "lost finale" created for this publication. Transit is the story of hero Spud and his fight against political corruption and Reverend Griss. Fans of McKeever will love that the book is finally available in a collected edition. Ted McKeever is unlike anyone else in the business. Seeing his work from the beginning of his career again after 20 years is a fantastic trip back in time.
